Since launching in 2008, over 250,000 visitors have participated in annual Doors Open events.

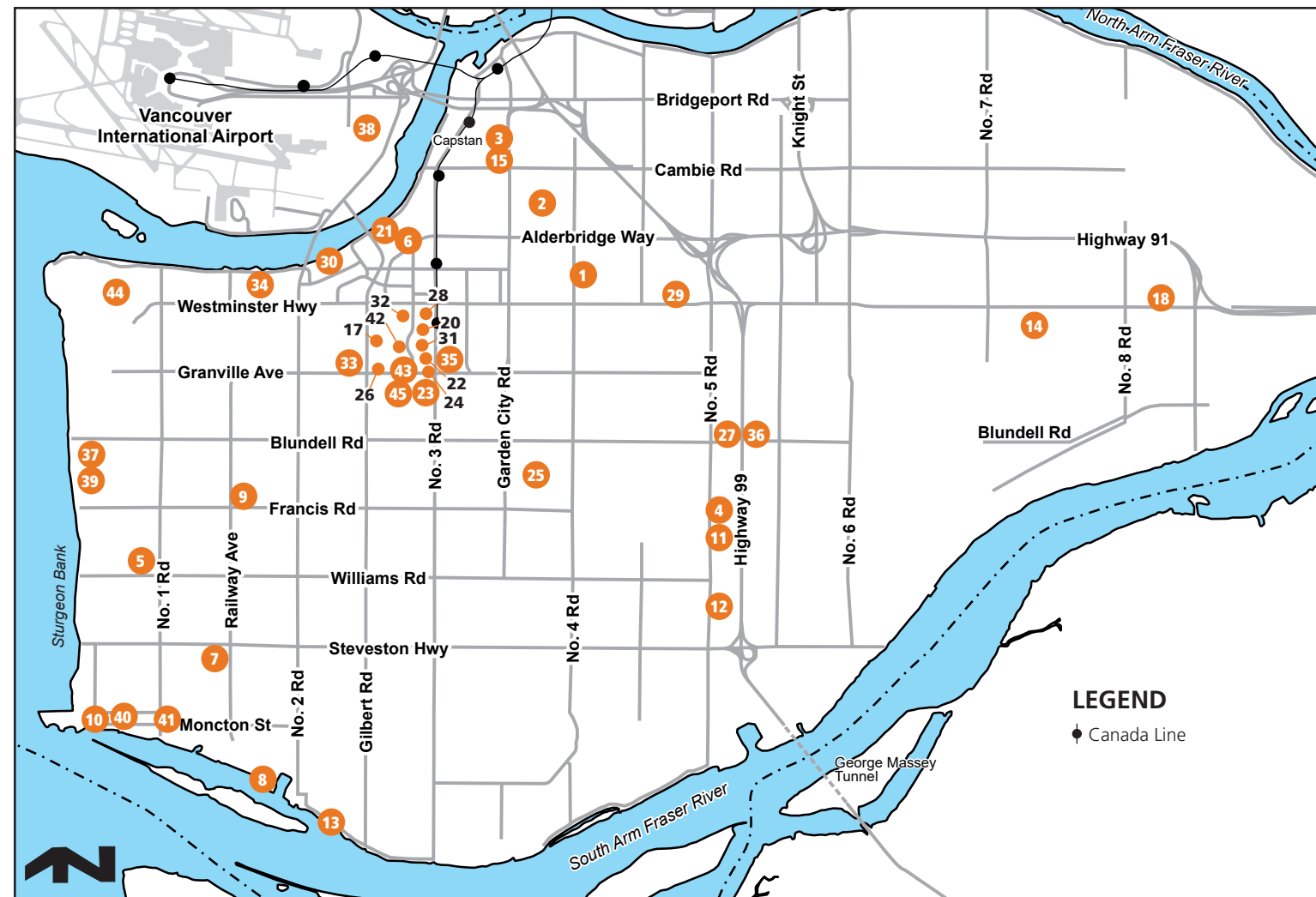
This year, over 40 sites that exemplify the city's rich history and diverse communities will open their doors to offer free activities on Saturday, June 6 and Sunday, June 7.
